

The Venue

Welcome to Akola, also known as the 'Cotton and Lemon City of India' due to its high cotton and citrus production. The district is also famous for its various shimmering rivers, gorgeous winters, sprawling forts, and Raj Rajeshwar Mahadev temple. Akola district is surrounded by Melghat Hills and forest region.

This National Seminar cum Workshop will be organized at City Sports Club Resort (CSC). It is located 8 km away from Akola city. CSC is spread over a sprawling stretch of lush green lawns. It features well equipped conferencing and banqueting venue.

Local Tour

Lonar lake

Lonar Lake, also known as Lonar crater, is a notified National Geo-heritage Monument, saline, soda lake, located at Lonar in Buldhana district, Maharashtra, India. Lonar is situated around 100 km from Akola and 360 km from Nagpur. Lonar lake is an astrobleme created by a meteorite impact during the Pleistocene Epoch. It is one of only four known hypervelocity impact craters in basaltic rock anywhere on Earth.

Shegaon

Shegaon has become a pilgrimage centre due to the blessings of Shri Sant Gajanan Maharaj, who is considered a saint and partial reincarnation of Lord Dattatreya. Visiting Gajanan Maharaj Temple at Shegaon is very gratifying and spiritual experience. Excellent and selfless services are provided by the devotees. It is the largest temple trust in the Vidarbha region and is known as the "Pandharpur of Vidarbha". Shegaon is located 46 km from Akola and 300 km west of Nagpur.







CONFERENCE PROGRAMME

Only invited keynote lectures will be presented orally on PPTx. format. Poster(s) should be prepared of 4' (L) X 3' (W) size on flex material with title, name of authors, affiliation, objectives, materials & methods, results and conclusions.

AWARDS

Best poster awards in each session will be bestowed.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation for delegates will be arranged in private hotels preferably at Conference venue i.e., CSC Resort, Akola. The tentative tariff will be Rs. 3000-6000/- per double room per day. However, budget hotels with a tariff of Rs. 1500-2500 may be arranged or directly booked through online mode. For students, accommodation will be arranged in Farmers Hostel of Dr. PDKV, Akola on payment basis at minimal charges.

Transport

Akola is well connected by road and train from different parts of the country. The nearest airport is Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport, Nagpur. Akola is 276 km from Nagpur and 570 km from Mumbai. The distance from Akola railway station and Bus stand to City sport club is about 10 km.
